Miss Petch will be leaving us in July. I am sure you will all join me in thanking her for her commitment to the children of Barningham CEVC Primary School. I know the children, staff and parents have loved working with her and will really miss her. We wish her all the best for her new ventures.

Mrs Cockle joined us in January to cover Mrs Smithson's maternity leave and has done such a wonderful job with Owls in the short time she has been with us. She will be with us until July and I am sure you would agree that she has settled in so well and quickly during a turbulent time. We wish her all the best in her new role in September.

Mrs Duncan will begin returning from maternity leave this half term and she will be working with Mrs Price preparing for September and working with the Reception pupils to make sure they are ready for September.

Mrs Smithson will be returning from maternity leave in October and her class will be covered by Mrs Price and Miss Garland.

Mr Rolfe will be coming to work with the new Owls on Tuesday 13th July for the whole day as part of their transition day. He will then be their full time class teacher from September.



Uniform

In the last week of half term, I sent around our updated uniform policy ready for September. As there have been some changes, I will be supporting parents in the following way:

• Extend the transition time so that the **new policy will come fully into place in September 2022**. This will allow families to have the year to move from navy to black and to purchase new uniform when their child grows out of their old uniform. This will also mean for children in Y6 next year, they won't need to buy new uniform for only the one year.

- I will be putting together a list of websites where you can order plain black trainers for relatively cheap they are easy to find and purchase as many schools have a black only trainer option. Shops like ShoeZone and Sports Direct do cheap pairs for around £15. I'll send this to parents separately. I will also add some links for suitable sports trousers/shorts that are low cost for parents.
- The move to black instead of navy will hopefully make it easier for parents as black items are much easier to locate and are usually therefore cheaper in the long run.

It is important that children come to school dressed ready to learn and it matches our vision of preparing children for their future. The office are working on ordering stock that matches the new uniform policy to make it easier for parents to order from school when possible.
