Active Week

Due to the COVID guidelines still being in force, **we will not be hosting a sports day with parents** this year. Instead, we will be having an 'Active Week' that will take place from Monday 5th July to Friday 9th July. Children will be allowed to wear their PE kits all week as they will be taking part in various sports activities both in class and outside including:

- Suffolk School Games Festival Activity Bingo cards with a range of activities to take part in at home and at school
- Tuesday 6th July: Activities run by Thurston Sports Partnership with Soft Archery for Squirrels and Parkour for Badgers and Owls
- Wednesday 7th July: Activities run by Explore Outdoor including Geocaching, Catapult building for Badgers and Owls and Bottle Rockets for Squirrels.
- Wednesday 7th July – Friday 9th July: Y5/6 Owls will be going to Kingswood
- All classes will be taking part in lessons around being active in class as well as extra sports related activities to encourage the importance of staying active!



Uniform

A reminder that the **new uniform policy will start in September 2021 and will come fully into place in September 2022**. This will allow families to have the year to move from navy to black and to purchase new uniform when their child grows out of their old uniform. This will also mean for children in Y6 next year, they won't need to buy new uniform for only the one year.
