Welcome!

Reception marks the beginning of your child's education and brings a time of mixed emptions for children, parents and staff, creating feelings of excitement, anticipation and expectation. The first few weeks of school are very valuable in getting to know each other and becoming familiar with the school routines. During this period we carry out a range of assessments in order to inform future planning and learning. This enables us to create challenges and appropriate activities for each individual.

All About Me!

We are really excited about our topic this half term.....'All about me!'. Children will be learning about what makes us special and how we are unique by looking at our similarities and differences. We have a history focus this half term with our learning based around the fertile question 'How have we changed over time'. This will include children investigating the childhoods of their parents and grandparents. They will take part in a range of engaging cross-curriculum activities to enhance their understanding of this topic.

Phonics

Children will have daily phonics sessions and lots of opportunities for writing. Please help you child write their name independently using a capital letter followed by lower case letters. Miss Garland will be leading a parent meeting on Thursday 29th September at 2:50-3:20pm to provide you with information and guidance on our new school phonic scheme and how you can support your child at home.

Reading

Once our children are settled into the school routines and we begin teaching phonics in class, we will send home reading books. Please ensure your child has their book at school every day. More information will be provided during the phonic meeting with Miss Garland. Please leave a comment in your child's reading log when you have listened to them read.

WOW moments

Every week we like to share the children's WOW moments. We will send home blank post it notes for you to write the WOW moments on and bring back into class. These WOW moments can be large or small moments in your child's life. We always like to promote the achievements and acknowledge their progress. For example a WOW moment could be 'Timmy helped lay the table at Nanny's house' or Jackie had her first swimming lesson'. The children love to see their WOW displayed and read out in front of their class!
