#### Sickness & Attendance

Whilst we are promoting good attendance this year in school, we know that children do get sick and at times will not be well enough to attend school. **Our new attendance policy states that all parents will receive a phone call to find out the reason for the child's absence**, whether a message has been left or not. This is so office staff can record this accurately and can offer advice around returning to school. If your child has been vomiting or has diarrhoea, please keep your child off school for 48 hours from the last point of sickness. This is to stop any spread of illness at school.

#### Cost of Living Support

All children would have received a leaflet today from Suffolk outlining the support available with finances and household expenses. We know this time is tough for many of our families so please read through this leaflet to find out more about what support is available. Our local Churches and Community are providing Food Bank Food locally for those who find themselves in need.
