# Skip2Bfit

The Skip2Bfit ropes will be available to buy in the school after the workshop. We will send home information about this separately.

### **Teacher Strike Action**

You may be aware from media coverage that National Education Union (NEU) have declared strike action, which will take place on Wednesday 1 February 2023, Wednesday 15 March 2023 and Thursday 16 March 2023. A further strike for the Eastern Region is scheduled to take place on Wednesday 1 March 2023. The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over teacher's pay and not because of any issues at individual schools.
