## School Dinners Price Increase

Education catering services across the UK, are suffering from the cost increases in food products, increased fuel costs for transport and food production, recruitment issues and the UK wage increases. Vertas, who supply our catering service will be therefore **increasing their cost per pupil meal to £2.50** (previously this was £2.30). This will be in effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 – straight after Easter break.
