### Emergency Alert (Sunday @ 3pm)

On Sunday 23 April 2023 at 3pm, there will be a national test of the UK Emergency Alerts service. I spoke to the children about this in assembly today so that they are aware and it doesn't scare them. Emergency Alerts is a UK government service that will warn you if there's a danger to life nearby. In an emergency, your mobile phone or tablet will receive an alert with advice about how to stay safe. Your mobile phone or tablet may:

- make a loud siren-like sound, even if it's set on silent
- vibrate
- read out the alert

The sound and vibration will last for about 10 seconds.
