### Who will be supporting your child/ren in Badger class?

### What will we be learning?

<b>Maths</b>	Multiplication and division, length and perimeter, fractions
<b>English</b>	The Great Chocoplot (fiction) and Earthquakes (non-fiction)
<b>Science</b>	Rocks, soils and fossils
<b>History</b>	Ancient Egypt.
<b>RE</b>	Hinduism
<b>French</b>	Food and birthdays
<b>Art/DT</b>	Ancient Egyptian scrolls

We will be going swimming on a Monday. Children will need to come in wearing their PE kit and have their swimming kit with them (costume/trunks, swimming hat, towel and goggles). We will be having our PE lesson with Ryan on a Thursday, so please wear weather appropriate clothing.

### Homework

<b>Spellings</b>
Your child will be sent home with spellings from the Y3/4 National Curriculum. These will be printed out and given to your child but they will also be in their reading record too. The spellings we will be focussing on each will be detailed on the print out. Your child will be tested on the highlighted spellings at the end of the week.
<b>Reading</b>
Please encourage your child to read daily. If they read to themselves, they are more than welcome to write in their reading records.
<b>Maths</b>
Your child is expected to access TTRS everyday for 3 minutes. This is especially important for Y4 as they have their MTC in June. If you need help accessing TTRS, let me know. We check this weekly as a class and also hold small tournaments in Badgers!
