Changes to Free School Meals

From the 1st April, there will be changes to pupils applying for Free School Meals. This does not affect pupils who already have FSM. It is important for schools to remind all parents and guardians who do not have a current claim or eligibility, to apply for this between now and the end of March 2025 if they think their child may be eligible, to ensure their claim and future funding are protected. Medical Appointments

Changes to Nursery Payments & Nursery Spaces

From Easter, as outlined in the parent letter sent on the 4th February, we will be taking advance payments for our Nursery spaces. This is to enable the school to plan staffing and catering arrangements based on the number of pupils attending each day. We still have some spaces in our Nursery and have some availability for 15 and 30 hour placements. From April 2025, the cost for a school lunch will increase to £2.80. Our school meals are provided by Vertas. They have notified us that this increase is due to inflation and increased cost of goods.
