Dear parents/carers,

Another busy term is about to begin! It will be packed full of learning, but also gives us an opportunity to focus on other things, such as our class end-of-year play. I know lots of the children are looking forward to rehearsing for this and I'd like to thank you in advance for helping the children learn their lines and prepare their costumes.

Our Learning:

In **English** the children will write stories based on the short film 'The Present' by Jacob Frey.

In **Maths** the children will be recapping formal written methods of multiplication and division, before consolidating learning on fractions, decimals and percentages.

In **Science** the children will be studying electricity, recognising symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.

In **Humanities** the children's learning will focus on Geography. The unit is titled My Place and will give pupils an opportunity to showcase the knowledge and skills they've developed throughout their time at primary school.

In **RE**, the children will focus on Buddhism and how the Buddha taught his followers to find enlightenment.

In **Computing**, the children will learn to programme using Kodu.

In their **DT** lessons, the children will learn how to create and programme Doodlers.

Developing their knowledge in **French**, the children will learn how to talk about the planets.

In **PE** this half-term, the children will develop skills in rounders and athletics.

### **Reading and Homework**

In UKS2 it is important that the children continue to read at home on a daily basis, remind your children to log all of their reading at home and make sure you have initialled/ signed your children's reading records when they have read. Please ensure that reading records are returned to school on a daily basis.

Normally at the start of each term, homework is sent home in the form of a project, linked to an area of learning. However, this half term I would like the children to spend time at home learning their lines for the play, 'The Jungle Book' and preparing their costume.

Times tables will continue to be a focus in UKS2. Please encourage the children to continue to use Times Tables Rock Stars so they can master their times tables. There is an expectation that they complete 15 garage games every week. Please speak to me if the children are having difficulty with this or there are problems accessing technology.

Spellings will be set each week and will come home on a Monday, glued into the reading records. These will be tested on a Friday. Please try to find some time to help the children to practice these as good spelling can have a huge impact on the quality of their written work.

### **Walking Home and Mobile Phones**

If you would like you child to walk themselves to or from school, please make sure you have completed the permission slip (these can be collected from the school office). If you would like them to have a mobile phone for this journey, please let us know and these can be dropped off to the office in the morning and collected at the end of the day. The children are not allowed to keep mobile phones on them during the school day.

### **PE kits**

PE will continue to be on Thursday and Friday this term, with enrichment PE on a Wednesday. Children will continue to come into school in their PE kits on their PE days, rather than changing at school. Please ensure your children are wearing shorts/jogging bottoms and PE t-shirts with trainers.
