### Summer Term 2: 2026

Dear parents/carers,

We are now coming towards the end of the school year and the final part of the summer term looks to be busy and exciting.

This half term we have lots of exciting topics to explore. In **English** we will begin by looking at poetry linked to a poem called 'If I Were in Charge of the World' and will then look at persuasive writing. In **Maths**, we will begin learning about: time; mass capacity and temperature; and position and direction. In **Science** learning will progress nicely from previous units where we will be exploring habitats. This half term the children will be studying **Geography** and learning about 'The United Kingdom'. In **RE** year 1 will study Judaism and will be exploring the question, 'Why Jewish families say so many prayers and blessings?'. Year 2 will be answering the question 'Why do Hindus want to collect good karma?'. This half term in **PE** the children will be learning about striking and fielding games and athletics. Finally, this term we will be studying **Design and Technology** where year 1 will make puppets and year 2 will be focussing on food, specifically adapting a recipe.
